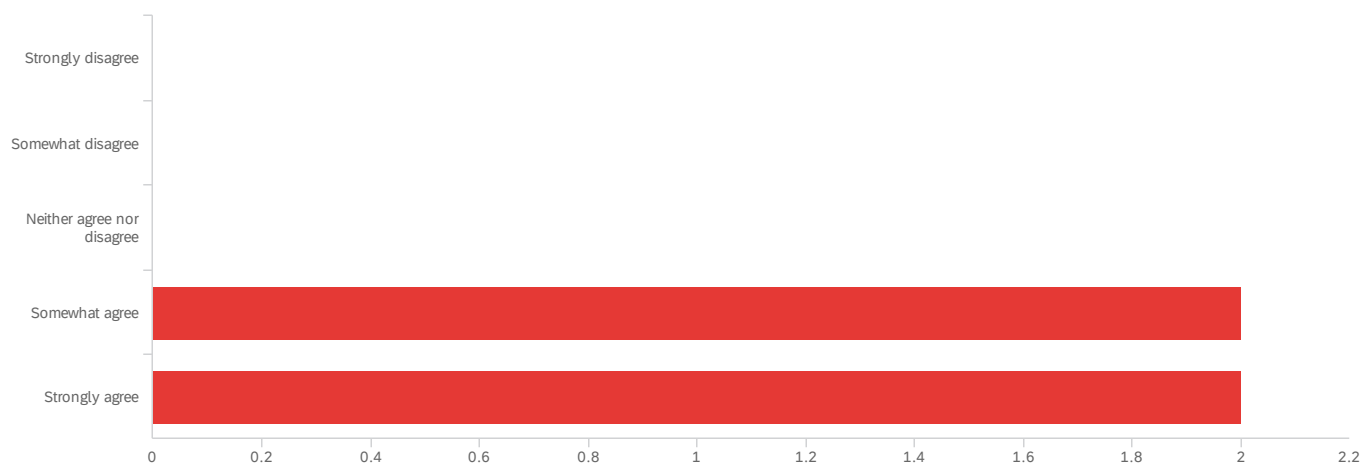

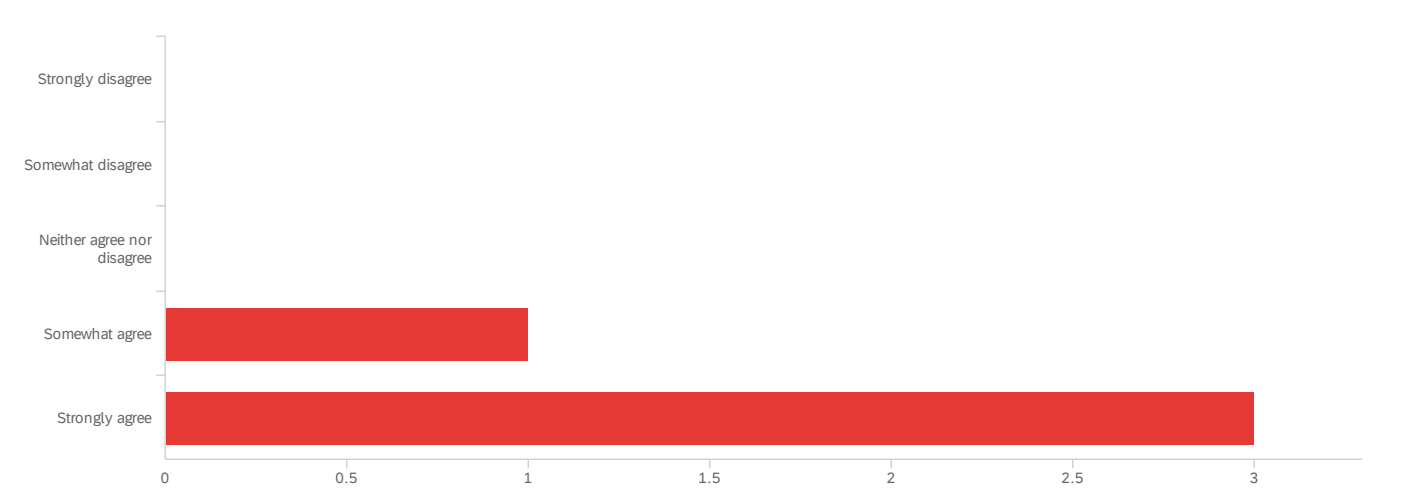

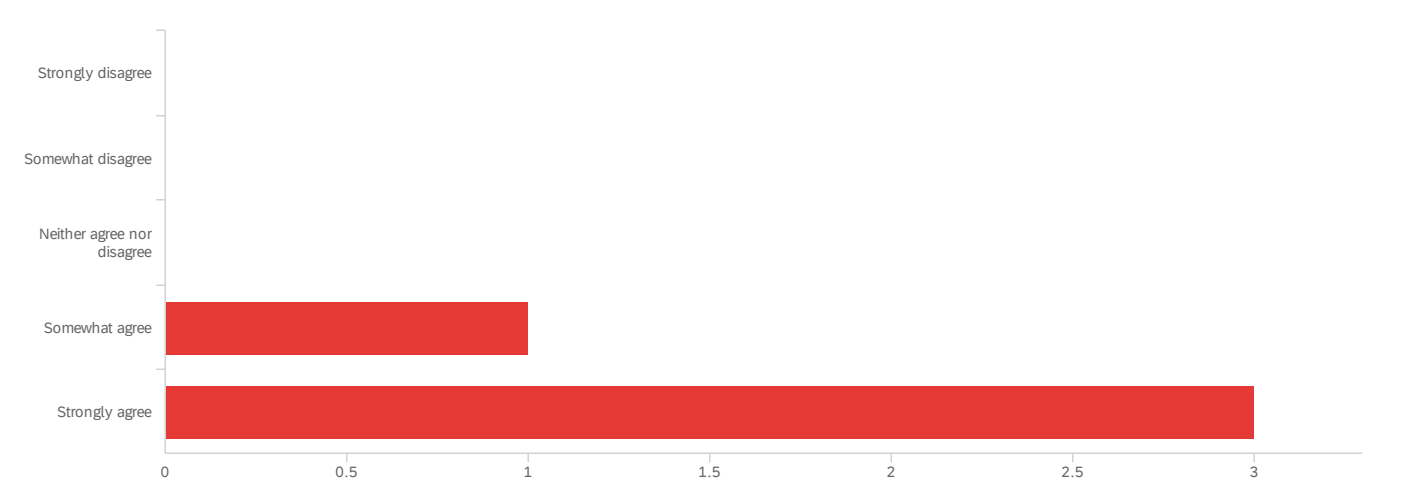

Q3 - The overall course structure helped me learn.

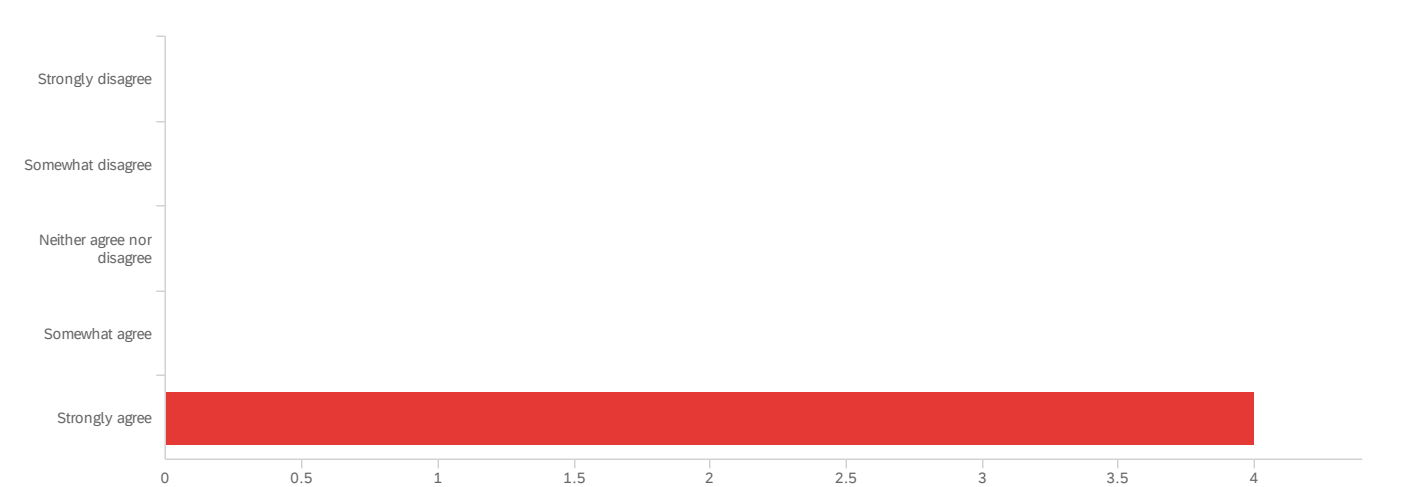

Q4 - I felt comfortable participating in group discussion.

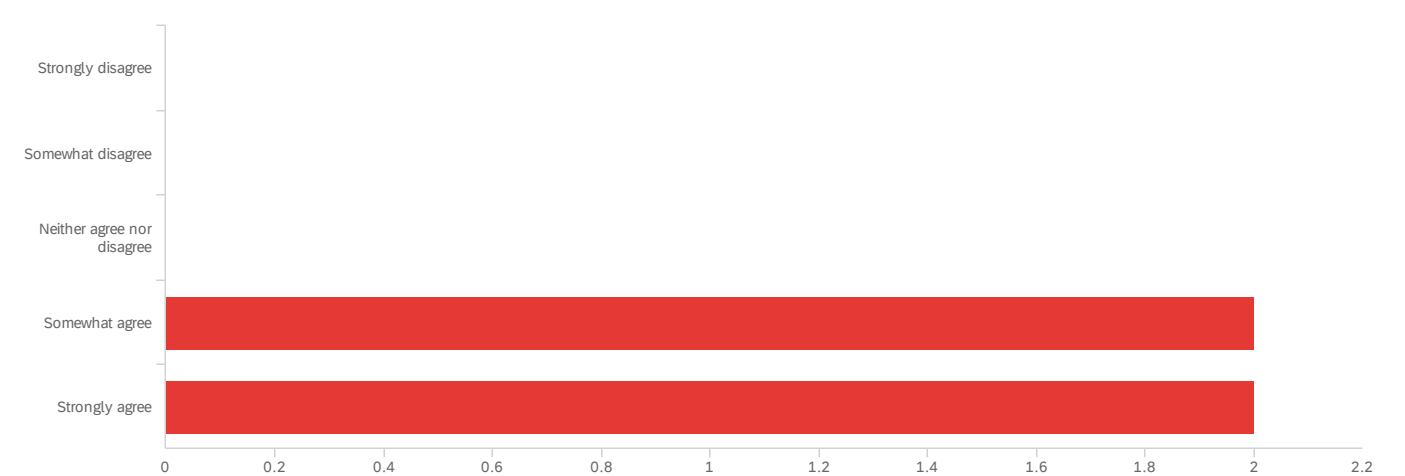

Q5 - Individual class sessions felt purposeful and structured.

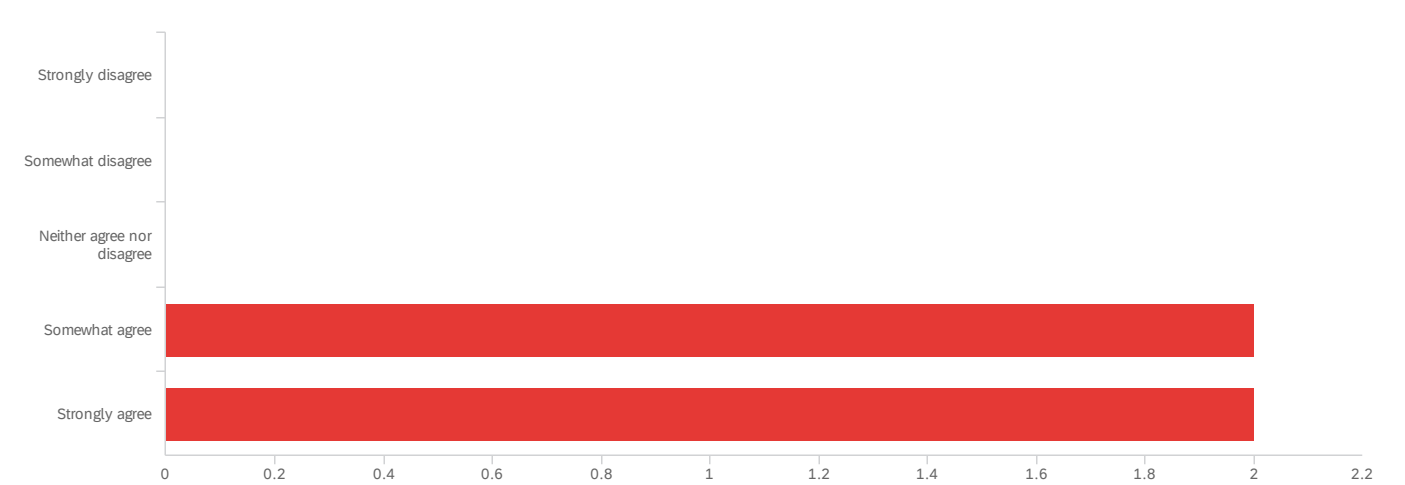

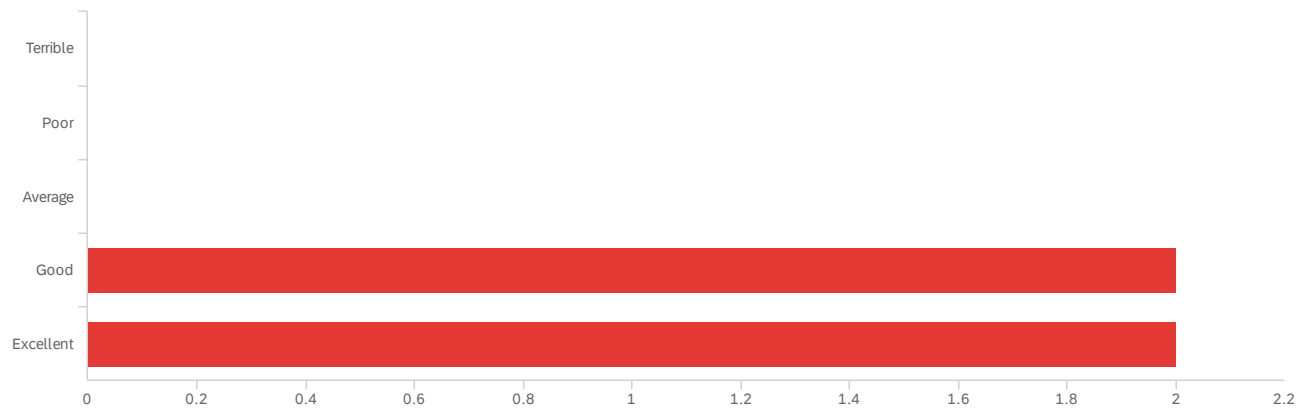

I'm not usually someone who begins readings far in advance so this might be my own problem, but we'd often have to read half a book from Friday to Wednesday (4 nights), and then the other half from Wednesday to Friday (2 nights), which was a bit stressful.

We kind of just jumped around from course theme to theme without actually going over what the new theme was. I think having a discussion about how each theme (foreign language, globalization, etc) related to sci-fi/aliens would have tied the course together better

I wish I could do the review assignment before the short papers. I think it is a good exercise that makes us think deeper than a surface level and would prepare us well for short papers.

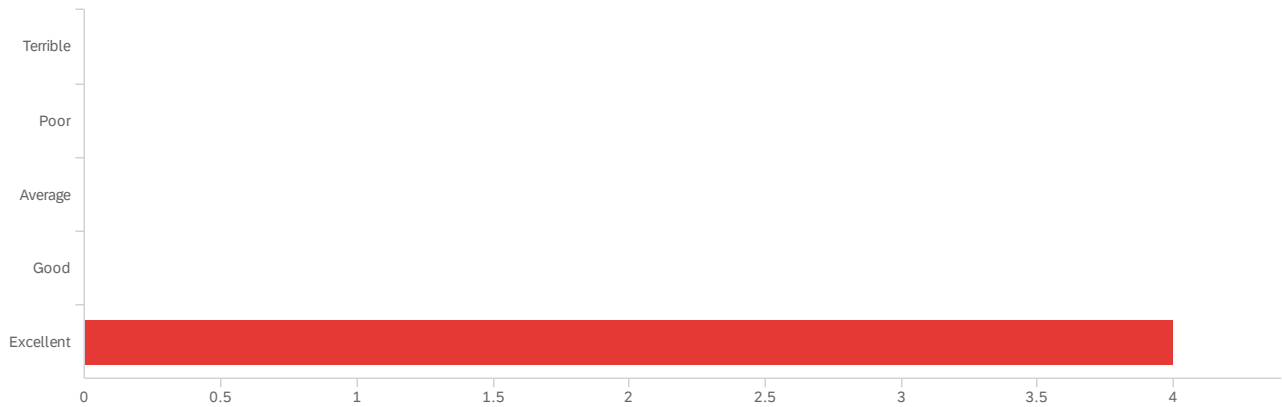
